Google Meet & Sharing Video/Audio

Work around for a PC (Windows 10)

1. Click on Start button
2. Open Settings
3. Click on System
4. Select Sound - Recording
5. List of devices, look for Stereo Mix and click enable



In Google Meet - to present a video or play an audio file:

1. Click on the three dots,
2. Go to Settings
3. Audio > MIC
4. Select STEREO MIX



Heads-Up: Using Stereo Mix, students/session participants won't be able to hear you speaking since the mic is disabled.
* Be sure to turn back on your mic after sharing the video or audio.

Tip: If you have two devices (laptop or phone), use one for presenting (videos or audio files) and the other to talk during the session.
